Membership Cards

As a Club we are governed by the Liquor Licensing Laws. Each member must be able to provide proof of their Membership, or visitor's status, by carrying their membership card or Visitors pass at all times. On a good note, swiping your card will get you through the front door and it will give you a discount on a purchase from the bar.

**Dress Code:** 

A smart casual standard of dress is required at all times. No bare feet, no torn clothing or work day-glow clothing/boots.

Behaviour:

We like to see people enjoying themselves and that all comes down to everyone portraying good behaviour patterns.

**Guests:** 

All guests MUST be signed in by an accompanying member and must leave when the member leaves. No local guest may be signed in more than once a month. Frequent use of the club will require membership.



If you have a guest visiting from overseas, we can provide a temporary membership for them, should they wish to use the Club for the duration of their stay.

Privacy:

Photos are not to be taken within the club without prior approval from those in the photo or Management consent.

**Gaming Area:** 

Entry into the gaming area is restricted to members and guests 18 years and over. Guests must be in receipt of a signed visitors pass before they can play or claim any prizes.

Smoking/Vaping

A smoking area is provided at the western end of the Deck. Please help us keep Browns Bay clean by using the ashtrays provided, rather than throwing it onto the roadway.

**Club Etiquette:** 

We do appreciate the effort when members return their empties to the bar.

Food:

Members and their guests are not permitted to bring their own food into the Bays Club. Only food from our restaurant or bar may be consumed on the premises.

**Entertainment:** 

Keep an eye open for regular live entertainment. We have had Tribute Shows such as Rud Steward, Freddy Mercury, Tina Turner and more. These will be displayed as you walk in the door, on the website <a href="https://www.baysclub.co.nz">www.baysclub.co.nz</a> and on Facebook Bays Club Inc. plus the TVs within the Club. Children under the age of 18 may not attend any of the Club Shows/Functions.

Children in the Club Children are welcome in the Bays Club lounge, and we ask the parents to respect other user's space while on the premises.

Children under the age of 18 are not permitted in the Gaming Area.

They must be under parent supervision when on the deck.
